PROJECT DESCRIPTION: *The proposed work consists of replacing approximately 900 feet of sanitary sewers serving the Sherman Place Subdivision via pipe bursting. The work includes new manholes, reconnecting service taps, and related restoration items.*

Drawings, Specifications, and blank bid forms may be obtained at the above office of the DESIGN ENGINEER upon payment of SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00) NON-REFUNDABLE. Contract Documents can be shipped at the Bidder's expense for an additional shipping and handling fee (NON-REFUNDABLE). Contract Documents will be shipped as soon as possible after receipt of request and payment for such documents. BIDS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED FROM BIDDERS LISTED ON THE ENGINEER'S OFFICIAL LIST OF PLANHOLDERS. Checks shall be made payable to Feller, Finch & Associates.

The estimated project cost is \$172,000.

A bid guarantee instrument must be submitted with the bid. The bid guarantee instrument shall be in the form of a Bid Guarantee and Contract Bond for the FULL AMOUNT of the bid OR a certified check, cashiers check, or irrevocable letter of credit for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. The bid guarantee shall be made payable to the City of Perrysburg, Ohio, and is to be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and a contract is awarded to the BIDDER, the contract will be duly executed and its performance properly secured. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

The successful BIDDER(s) shall be required to furnish a Contract Bond in a sum of not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the total contract amount. The bond shall be that of an approved surety company authorized to transact business in the State of Ohio and shall be underwritten by a surety that is listed on the most current Department of the Treasury Circular 570, "Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds".

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the Ohio EEO Requirements shall be required.

Bidders must pay Prevailing Wage Rates for Wood County, Ohio.

Bidders must submit with this Bid the affidavit required under Ohio Revised Code Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Wood County, Ohio (Section 00655-1 in the bid documents) and the affidavit required by the Ohio revised code section 3517.13 (Section 00665-1 in the bid documents).

Each bid proposal must be made upon the blanks, or facsimiles thereof, furnished with the Contract Documents, and must be delivered to the City of Perrysburg, 201 W. Indiana Ave., Perrysburg, OH 43551, previous to 1:30 p.m. local time, on the date specified.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

The City of Perrysburg reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received, and to accept any bid that it deems most favorable.
