### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

St. John's Jesuit High School new synthetic state-of-the-art track and turf field was completed in the summer of 2011. Six sports at the Varsity, Junior Varsity and Freshman levels will benefit from this new capital project including football, soccer, lacrosse, track, rugby and cross country. Preliminary design on the approximately 12,000 SF stadium building included locker rooms, offices, concession area, therapy training room, team meeting room, conference room and logo store. More than 70 percent of all students are actively involved in athletics at SJJ. A new 400 meter track with eight lanes encircles the athletic field and approximately 3,600 stadium seats were reinstalled to increase visibility. The positioning of the athletic field was slightly realigned to allow for the best use of space for surrounding practice fields. The new project replaced the existing athletic field that was installed when the school was originally constructed in 1965. "A new athletic field and surrounding track is a necessary addition to the SJJ campus. It is an investment in our future that allows this school to remain a dominant force in athletics in northwest Ohio and throughout the state," said Board Chair Geoff Lyden. The cost of the project was \$1.5 million. Feller, Finch and Associates provided the architectural, civil engineering and construction staking services for the project.
