INVITATION TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals will be received at the Pemberville-Freedom Fire Department, 104 East Front Street, Pemberville, OH 43450, until 2:00 PM Local Time August 6, 2019, at which time they will be opened and read immediately thereafter for the:

FREEDOM TOWNSHIP FY 2019 ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed work consists of: A) the widening of approx. 5,600 linear feet of Housekeeper Road from SR 199 to the west Township Limits to 18.5 feet. This entire stretch of Housekeeper Road will then be resurfaced with 1-1/2 inches of asphalt. B) Wayne Rd from Alexander Rd to N. River Rd. (approx. 6,580 feet) will be resurfaced with 2 inches of asphalt. C) Alexander Rd from Wayne Rd to the Portage River Trail walking path (approx. 2,600 feet) will be resurfaced using tar and chip. D) Wegman Rd from Sugar Ridge Rd to a point approx. 1900 feet south will be resurfaced using tar and chip. Areas with base failures in each section will be cut out and repaired with a full depth patch prior to resurfacing. The work generally includes excavation, stone base, asphalt pavement, drive approaches, stone berm, and related restoration items.

Drawings, Specifications, and blank bid forms must be obtained at the above office of the ENGINEER upon payment of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) NON-REFUNDABLE. Contract Documents can be shipped at the Bidder's expense for an additional shipping and handling fee (NON-REFUNDABLE). Contract Documents will be shipped as soon as possible after receipt of request and payment for such documents. Any additional sets shall be at the noted costs. BIDS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED FROM BIDDERS LISTED ON THE ENGINEER'S OFFICIAL LIST OF PLANHOLDERS. Checks shall be made payable to Feller, Finch & Associates, Inc.

A bid guarantee instrument must be submitted with the bid. The bid guarantee instrument shall be in the form of a Bid Guarantee and Contract Bond for the FULL AMOUNT of the bid OR a certified check, cashiers check, or irrevocable letter of credit for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid. The bid guarantee shall be made payable to the Freedom Township Trustees, and is to be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and a contract is awarded to the BIDDER, the contract will be duly executed and its performance properly secured.

The successful BIDDER(s) shall be required to furnish a Contract Bond in a sum of not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the total contract amount. The bond shall be that of an approved surety company authorized to transact business in the State of Ohio and shall be underwritten by a surety that is listed on the most current Department of the Treasury Circular 570, "Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds".

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project must use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor to the extent practicable, and pay Ohio Prevailing Wage Rates for Wood County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wages and Hour Division. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal opportunity requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES OR THROUGH <http://codes.ohio.gov/orc/153.011>

Each proposal must contain full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity. The Contractor shall be pre-qualified with the Ohio Department of Transportation.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received, and to accept any bid that it deems most favorable.
